

Student Membership Policy and Procedure

Student membership with Audiology Australia includes benefits such as:

- a waiver of any membership fees for the duration of your Audiology Australia accredited Masters-level degree in Australia;
- free transfer to full membership following graduation and our receipt of your Membership Transfer form;
- access to a wide range of free and reduced-fee Audiology Australia and other conferences and events; and
- professional advocacy, support and advice.

APPLICATION STEPS

In order to obtain student membership with Audiology Australia you must have:

1. Submitted the Audiology Australia Student membership application form, which includes:
 - a. Providing proof of identity;
 - b. Providing proof of enrolment at one of the following Masters-level degrees accredited by Audiology Australia:
 - i. Macquarie University, Master of Clinical Audiology
 - ii. University of Queensland, Master of Audiology Studies
 - iii. Flinders University, Master of Audiology
 - iv. The University of Melbourne, Master of Clinical Audiology
 - v. La Trobe University, Master of Audiology
 - vi. The University of Western Australia, Master/PhD in Clinical Audiology
 - c. Having your membership application proposed and seconded by a full member of Audiology Australia
2. Your application for membership will then be sent for approval by the Board of Audiology Australia.
3. After approval by the Board, your name is circulated to members of Audiology Australia by the National Office. If no objections have been received within 28 days, your application will proceed.
4. You will then be sent an invoice and asked to pay the joining fee* for first-time members of Audiology Australia.

**Note: this fee is a once-only fee that covers the administrative costs associated with joining Audiology Australia for the first time.*
