

AUDIOLOGY AUSTRALIA INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURE

In order to be accepted into the Audiology Australia Internship Program, applicants must have met the Audiology Australia Full membership requirements, which includes meeting the Stage 1 Certificate of Clinical Practice (CCP) assessment criteria.

Completion of the Clinical Internship is one of the assessment criteria for meeting Stage 2 of the CCP application.

INITIAL APPLICATION

1. The application for full membership and Stage 1 of the CCP assessment criteria has been met.
2. The Clinical Internship Registration Form has been submitted, which includes the Supervisor Declaration and applicant's signature.
 - a. The Clinical Internship applicant needs to be employed in an audiology clinic, with a supervisor who is a Full Member of Audiology Australia and who holds a current CCP. It is the responsibility of the applicant to obtain the agreement of an audiologist holding a CCP to act as their supervisor.
3. Complete all other initial documentation requirements as outlined in the Clinical Internship Handbook, which is available on the members-only pages of Audiology Australia's website.

DURING THE CLINICAL INTERNSHIP

4. Complete all requirements outlined in the Clinical Internship Handbook, which is available on the members-only pages of Audiology Australia's website.

FOLLOWING COMPLETION OF CLINICAL INTERNSHIP

5. On completion of the Clinical Internship, the Intern and their Supervisor must sign a "Certificate of Clinical Practice Award Application Form" declaring that the Clinical Internship, as registered with Audiology Australia, has been duly and fully completed and that the applicant has attained the required standards of clinical practice.
6. Upon satisfactory completion of all requirements for the clinical certification program the applicant will be awarded a CCP provided they have paid all relevant membership and CCP fees.
7. After the applicant has been awarded the CCP they will be enrolled in the Continuing Professional Development program and will be advised by Audiology Australia of the requirements of this program.
