Dr. Gurjit Singh is a Senior Research Audiologist at Sonova Holding AG, an Adjunct Lecturer at the University of Toronto, and an Adjunct Professor at Ryerson University. Gurjit’s research interests include teleaudiology, factors that contribute to speech understanding in noise, emotion, and clinical decision-making.

Session topics:

- Factors motivating teleaudiology in clinical practice, specifically reviewing why teleaudiology is likely to have a larger role in clinical practice.
- A review of the attitudes of key stakeholders toward teleaudiology based on qualitative and quantitative research.
- Audiological outcomes following face-to-face and remote appointments using evidence from research that compares short-term audiological outcomes following appointments conducted in a face-to-face manner versus appointments conducted in remote fashion.
