

SCHEDULE OF FEES

FOR ACCREDITATION OF AUDIOLOGY PROGRAMS - FROM 1 JULY 2021

Accreditation Assessment

1. Accreditation assessment fee of \$9,000 (plus GST)

Charged in the last year of the 5-year cycle for existing accredited programs for their accreditation assessment, or for an initial accreditation assessment of a new program in an out-of-cycle assessment.

Applicable in the year the university undergoes their site visit assessment.

Universities will be invoiced on receipt of application documentation which is due three months prior to the site visit.

2. Site visit costs will be additional and on cost recovery basis

The associated site visit costs of travel, airfares, taxi fares, accommodation, meals, and any other expenses associated with a site visit by the Accreditation Assessment Panel will be the responsibility of the university.

The invoice is issued after the site visit. This cost is not applicable for site visits conducted in online mode.

Annual fee

Annual fee of \$4,500 (plus GST)

Charged every year for accredited programs, excluding the year in which the accreditation assessment visit occurs.

Universities will be invoiced for the annual fee by 31 January in each applicable year.

Monitoring/follow-up site visits

Fees for monitoring/follow-up visits to be determined on a case-by-case basis.

The associated site visit costs of travel, airfares, taxi fares, accommodation, meals, and any other expenses associated with a monitoring site visit by the Accreditation Assessment Panel or members thereof will be the responsibility of the university.

Site visit costs will be charged on a cost recovery basis. The invoice for site visit costs is issued after the site visit. This cost is not applicable for site visits conducted in online mode.

Any fees for monitoring/follow-up visits other than site visit costs to be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Failure to pay outstanding invoices by the time specified by AudA may result in accreditation being revoked, or an assessment being delayed or not being undertaken.
